



## Cambridgeshire Historic Churches Trust



Holy Trinity Church Hildersham has recently installed water and drainage for an accessible lavatory in a newly built North Porch and water supply for a kitchenette in the West Tower, which will be known in future as The Margaret Bate Room.

This has been made possible with the aid of a grant of £3,000 and an interest free loan of £20,000 from **Cambridgeshire Historic Churches Trust**.

The Trust helps congregations with the repair and enhancement of their historic places of worship by offering grants and loans. Its main source of funding is the CHCT annual 'Ride, Drive and Stride'. Each September cyclists, motorists and walkers of all ages throughout Cambridgeshire find people to sponsor them for a number of churches, chapels and colleges that they visit on the day. Half the money is returned to the participants' nominated church or chapel, the other half goes to help churches with the cost of repairs.
